Adult Literacy Program launch!

An educator's hope for the nations

One of the greatest needs and one of the truest burdens of our hearts has been the rampant illiteracy in the West African countries we serve. Several years ago, we met a couple who are innovative educators in the state of California. We were brought together by God's providence and in 2021 began working together with our ministry partners in West Africa to begin to meet that need.

Using the Bible as our textbook, we endeavored to employ a unique method of teaching literacy in Sierra Leone among a population that uses English as their 3rd language. Excitement was hard to contain as many of the students were reading - and understanding what they were reading for the first time in their adult lives!

The adult literacy program launched into another community in Sierra Leone, then again into a village in Ghana. We were excited to learn that some of the students in the Ghanaian village were even coming from the Fulani encampment nearby.

Now, as we begin 2022, we are exploring the feasibility of launching the adult literacy program among 300 mission stations in Nigeria which are also among the Fulani. May the hearts of the Fulani be drawn to our humble Shepherd, Jesus Christ!
